

Michael and Kay Fabrizio have been married for 11 years. They met May 28, 2001 on the back lawn of the Daniel Island Club (love at first sight!), and have been happily "joined at the hip" since that day. They have three grown children, Jonathan, Jennifer and Lauryn, a junior at the University of Florida. They also have three grandchildren. Kay moved to Mt. Pleasant in 2001 and Michael moved back to the area in 1999.

Most of Michael's career has been in the East Cooper area in the golf business. Immediately after graduating from North Carolina State University, he started at Wild Dunes during construction in December 1979. He left in 1983 to build and maintain Dataw Island Club in Beaufort, and returned to Wild Dunes for 7 more years in 1988. He currently is the Director of Grounds at the Daniel Island Club, where he has been since it inception in 1999. He is also a Past President of the Carolinas Golf Course Superintendents Association. Knight of the Month March, 2014 Chris Anderson

Originally from Fayetteville, Arkansas, Chris Anderson met his wife Julia in downtown Charleston in 1993. Married six years later at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, they have one son, Graham, age 5, in kindergarten at Christ Our King/Stella Maris. Graham is learning karate, plays soccer, and has developed the reputation of being the class scientist. Graham is an inquisitive little guy--he collects rocks, loves taking things apart, uses his microscope to investigate, and sets traps for dad with his laser beam detectors.

A biology major, Chris graduated from College of Charleston, and Julia, a Nurse Practitioner, graduated from MUSC. The last ten years they've lived in Tampa, FL and Mt. Pleasant, SC due to Chris' jobs with US Central Command, Air Force, and the U.S. Dept. of Labor involving safety, emergency management, and mishap response actions in the U.S. and Middle East. Chris is currently Director/Chief of Safety at Joint Base Charleston as a DOD civilian.

Chris joined the Knights at St. Benedicts 6 months ago and attain his 2nd and 3rd degrees March 22, 2014 at Christ Our King. He is currently serving as our Council Youth Director and has a project planned to rehab the landscaping and entrance to the East Cooper Senior Daycare Center in April 2014.

Dear Brother Knights,

Are you trying to get some growth on your savings, or start something for your retirement? Are you looking for an alternative to the stock market?
