

GOD BLESS AMERICA

Meditation-Having a Child-like Relationship with God

Ex 3:1-6; Ps 103:1-4, 6-8; Mt 11: 25-27

The readings I reference above call upon us to be child-like in our relationship with God.

God wants to be a part of our lives. It is really that simple. The so-called wise and learned of the world, like the Scribes and Pharisees of old, are too smart or too busy in their lives to understand this.

We are reminded to call out to God when we are in trouble or have needs. He hears us and will, in His time and in His way, help us. We just need to have faith in him. This is something that will never be revealed to the Scribes and Pharisees of our day

In the reading from the Book of Exodus, Moses has his first encounter with God. It only happens because of his child-like curiosity. He is tending sheep for his father-in-law, Jethro, when he sees a burning bush. Most people, in their busy-ness or their self-centeredness, would either not notice the burning bush or could care less.

Not Moses. He goes over to the bush, only to have a voice come from the bush. It calls out "Moses, Moses..." At this point, many people, who had taken the time to look at the bush, would run away from fear of the unknown. Not Moses. He begins a discussion with the voice who he, in his child-like faith, recognizes to be God.

God tells Moses he has heard the cries of the Israelites, just like God hears our cries, his faithful. God wants to intervene because He has seen and heard the cries of the suffering people and wishes to lead them out of Egypt.

What we have is a need that is expressed to a loving God who, in His way and in His time, is answering the need. God is doing it through Moses, who has come to God with a child-like faith, and, as a result, God reveals Himself to Moses. Moses becomes one of the greatest leaders in the history of Israel, leading them from their slavery in Egypt.

In the Gospel of Mathew, Jesus tells us His Father has hidden the truths about who Jesus is from the wise and the learned. The wise and the learned are the Scribes and the Pharisees. They have rejected Jesus' preaching and the significance of His mighty deeds.

The truth is that Jesus is the Son of God, who has come into the world so that our sins will be forgiven. Whoever has child-like faith will, to the extent possible, have peace, joy and happiness in this world and will live with Him in Heaven for eternity. This truth is revealed to the child-like, to us. We can accept this truth because our minds are open to receive it and because we refuse to be arrogant.

Let us never hesitate to call out to God. It might be because we need an extra dose of faith due to some challenge we are going through. It might be because we are experiencing some difficulty in our lives, like a health crises, for us or for a family member. God hears us and will send us what we need to get through this. We just need to have a child-like faith that it will happen.
