

One of the idioms of modern society is, "The only constant is change." Whether we like it or not, it is here to stay. And the Knights are changing too.

In the past year the Knight's insurance program has made several positive changes. Some of them are: We offer disability insurance. We have now risen the maximum age for whole life to age 80. And we now offer a 10 pay life insurance policy.

The only negative change is in new annuities. Reflecting our current economy, new annuities have a guarantee of 1.5% instead of the previous 3% or 3.5%. But with no sales charges and no fees, this is still more than competitive. And if money is put into a new contract it will earn 2.75% for the first year. (If you currently have an annuity, all money in there and any money added will still earn the guaranteed rate in the contract.)

The Knights also have several constants. We have the highest possible ratings for any domestic insurer from Standard & Poor's and from Moody's ratings services. We have the highest dividends in the industry. We are owned by our members and are here for our members. And finally, we are unapologetically Catholic.

In the next few months, I'll cover these topics separately, but if any of them are of interest now, please contact me for more information.
