The Daughters of St. Paul, founded in 1915, serve in fifty-two countries. Thirty-six years ago they began their service in Charleston with a bookmobile ministry. Today, located in the historic two-hundred year old Siegling Music House, they welcome everyone into their Pauline Book and Media Center to find a book store, Chapel and peaceful interior garden. They fill the center with the best Catholic/Christian media and religious art. There they run weekly bible studies and Lectio Divina via Zoom. The sisters travel often to bring the Word to parishes, Christian communities and special events. They are also present with the Word through radio and social media. The Paulines' mission, carried out alongside staff and lay volunteers, proclaims the luminous way of life that is the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Proceeds from the 2021 tournament will help fund the repair of the aging, leaking roofs (a total of four) on their building.
